Halston Chapel, Halston Hall, Whittington, SY11 4NS



You are invited to come to one of two tours as part of your Ride+Stride route, or as a single visit. Donations made on the day will be shared with the Shropshire Historic Churches Trust. Halston Hall Chapel is a grade I listed timber-framed chapel that lies isolated in the ground of Halston Hall. The chapel is one of only two timber framed churches in Shropshire and was constructed in the second half of the 15th century. It is also remarkable for the survival and quality of its early C17 and C18 fittings, the latter paid for by Richard Mytton (died 1731). It was built for a preceptory of the Knights Hospitallers that was at Halston from the late 12th century.
